Test report University of Düsseldorf

Bardahl hand cleanser has been extensively tested by the skin clinic of the medical faculty of the University of Düsseldorf, West Germany. This institute is a leader in the field of research into cleaning agents, their effect and influence in practice. During the test, the skin of 50 subjects was continuously exposed to the product 24 hours a day, for 3 days. In addition, no skin change was observed in any of the subjects.
